## Real-world **Experiences**

We believe that theory is nothing without practice. As an ESCP student, you will gain valuable hands-on business management experience with a focus on working as a team, cross-cultural communication and applying your newly acquired knowledge to real-world situations.

## **Internships and Social Impact Projects**

Internships and Social Impact Projects are the ultimate opportunity for you to put learned concepts and skills into practice in real business situations. These experiences are a crucial component of the BSc programme and are highly valued by potential employers. Instead of the second-year Internship, students can opt to complete a Social Impact Project, volunteering for a local charity or taking part in a humanitarian mission abroad. Social Impact Projects are particularly relevant for students interested in future work with notfor-profit organisations.

Thanks to ESCP's strong links with the corporate world, students are offered internships across a range of sectors, including Marketing & Communications, Banking & Finance, Consulting, Food & Beverage, Luxury Brands, E-commerce & IT, Automotive, Pharmaceuticals & Healthcare, Energy & Chemicals, and NGOs.



### **Business Games**

Business Games are online simulations played by teams of students in order to compete in a virtual business environment. An exciting and relevant exercise, the aim is to introduce you to the complexity of business decision-making. Each team must make decisions relating to areas such as finance, marketing and operations. The best-performing team wins the game and each team has the possibility to further their experience by participating in international competitions (e.g. Solvay Business Game and L'Oreal Brandstorm).

## **Collective Projects**

Collective Projects offer students an opportunity to contribute to the life of their programme and campus whilst acquiring practical managerial and leadership skills. At the beginning of each of your first two academic years, you will work in small teams to identify and plan the development of a project for the rest of the academic year. Projects can be varied in terms of their focus, and may be linked with careers, social life, humanitarian aid or be more business/ digital oriented. Students are encouraged to be creative.

## **Work and Study Track**

Students studying in Paris in their final year will be on a work and study track. Half of their time will be spent attending academic classes at ESCP Paris Campus and the other half working within a company based in Paris. This allows students to deepen their experience in the corporate world while completing their studies.

Students on the work and study track must be European citizens who can demonstrate a minimum of a C1 level (CEFR) in French.

# Careers **Service**

**The ESCP Careers Service helps** students identify their professional objectives to ensure their career prospects.

Located on each of the six campuses, the Careers Service provides students with the advice. data and tools to connect them to companies. ESCP students have access to over 30,000 internship opportunities each year.

### **Events**

The Careers Service hosts a range of events for students each year to help them define and refine their career plans, obtain valuable information. and learn about different job opportunities internationally.

These events include:

- · Career workshops
- · Company presentations, seminars, conferences. roundtables and interviews with recruiters
- · On-campus general and industry-specific job fairs attracting over 130 companies throughout the year
- · Bootcamps on Consulting, Banking, Tech and Marketing led by ESCP Alumni on how to be recruited by the leading companies in these sectors

### **Career Coaching**

Our Careers Service offers our students individual coaching to assist their career development, helping them identify their objectives, apply for jobs, write CVs, practice with mock interviews, and other relevant career training.

The Service uses a variety of tools to accompany students in discovering career goals and aspirations, such as personality and logic tests in order to:

- · Identify their strengthsand weaknesses
- · Help them reflect on a career
- · Train with practical guides and tutorials
- · Prepare for interviews

### Alumni

# Promoting an Entrepreneurial Spirit

**ESCP** places an increasing value on cultivating and nurturing an entrepreneurial spirit: as relevant for established businesses as for start-ups. Our Chair for **Entrepreneurship, created in** 2007, was a token of our strong belief that an entrepreneurial spirit is important for all students in all disciplines. In 2018 the **Jean-Baptiste Say Institute was** launched to offer a European academic reference dedicated to entrepreneurial leadership and innovation.

### Learning to be an Entrepreneur

Entrepreneurship is taught through specialisations that take students through the stages of self-reflection and leadership style through the essential business functions (finance, marketing, organisational development, etc.).

### Incubators and accelerators:

The School has three 'Blue Factory' incubators in Berlin. Madrid and Paris. as well as an accelerator in Paris. The creation of more than 600 companies has been supported since 2007.

**Events** include real and simulated opportunities for students to pitch their business ideas to panels of investors and experienced entrepreneurs. Highlights are the annual 'Innovation & Entrepreneurship Award' and the 'Made in ESCP' pitching event in Paris. In addition, during the annual Global Entrepreneurs Week, Entrepreneurship Festivals are organised at each of our campuses.

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# Student

A strong sense of school spirit and community is a defining characteristic of ESCP. ## The ESCP Regatta: Students and Alumni sail together

The ESCP Regatta symbolises what ESCP is all about. Once a year, students from all five campuses, as well as members of staff, faculty and alumni, gather in Italy for a weekend at sea. The event is a unique opportunity to fully exploit the potential of a multicampus school and to strengthen and broaden the group spirit key to the ESCP community.

The ESCP Regatta has become a landmark in the School's sporting, networking and social calendar. More than 400 participants sailed together in 2019, manning over 35 yachts around Porto Rotondo in Sardinia, Italy. ### **AGORA**

- English language test scores (if required): IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL 90 / CAE 180
- · CV/Resume
- · Supporting documents for additional languages spoken
- · Copy of ID/Passport

### STEP 2 Oral interview

If your initial application is successful, you will be invited to attend an oral interview with at least two people, including faculty members.

The interview is designed to assess your motivation, the match between your profile and your curriculum, and your personality (adaptability, maturity, openness to an international experience, etc.).

Whilst we prefer to meet students in person, distance interviews may be available.

### STEP 3 Admission results

The School will send you the admission results and, if you are admitted, you will be offered:

- · A place (unconditional or conditional) on the programme with a deadline by which to
- · Your track (e.g. 1st year: London / 2nd year: Turin / 3rd year: Berlin)

In order to confirm your enrolment, you will need to pay a deposit of €2,500.

Non-European Economic Area (EEA) and non-Swiss nationals will need a visa to study in the UK or EU. ESCP is able to sponsor students for their visas and to provide the required Visa Letter upon confirmation of enrolment. Please be aware you must refer to the relevant government website(s) for updated visa information.

Non-EU/EEA students joining the Bachelor in Management (BSc) programme starting in London and applying for a UK Tier 4 visa will need to provide evidence of their English level via: TOEFL, IELTS or Pearson.

If you are unable to take one of these tests, the London Campus team can arrange an in-house English Language test.

## Fees, scholarships & financing



At ESCP, we believe in equal opportunities. That is why we have created a scholarship programme that encourages social diversity and values individual commitment.

Scholarships can cover 10% to 50% of tuition fees (excluding first-year registration fee) and are assigned based on different criteria such as merit and financial needs. They are renewable each year on condition of academic achievement, behaviour and involvement in the ESCP community.

### **Bank Loan**

Many banks offer student loans at attractive rates, with deferred payback. Recent ESCP students have received interest rates as low as 1%. Consult your bank for information on a personal loan.

Furthermore, thanks to a partnership with BNP Paribas, the ESCP Foundation Endowment Fund supports students who encounter difficulties to obtain student credit in the absence of a solid guarantor (please note that this is currently only available for French students).


