





We live in a complex world — solving its problems requires creative and critical thinking. Whether it's curing cancer or combating climate change, our most pressing issues require input from across disciplines. Working with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), we are excited to offer a holistic STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics) education that teaches students how to solve for the future.

IMMERSION IN TECHNOLOGY

Our interdisciplinary STEAM program, created in partnership with MIT, is all about giving your child the tools to achieve more in our tech-driven world. Through hands-on problem solving, interdisciplinary learning and developing transferable skills, our STEAM program immerses students from an early age in the intersection of programming, engineering, robotics, and design.

LEARNING FROM LEADING THINKERS

Our students and educators have the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to learn from leading MIT scientists in person. Every spring, North Broward Preparatory students visit MIT to discover the innovations shaping their future. They engage in hands-on activities from building robots to bioengineering to coding. Our STEAM teachers also participate in MIT training workshops, where they are exposed to the forefront of STEAM thinking through discussions with leading researchers.

OUT-OF-THE-BOX CHALLENGES

Uniting their knowledge of science and technology, our in-school challenges invite students to try and find innovative and creative solutions to the world's greatest puzzles. In a previous challenge, North Broward Preparatory students blended ingenuity and imagination with Nord Anglia Education peers from around the world to construct a chain reaction machine. In collaboration with the renowned Juilliard School, we are proud to provide quality opportunities for your child to advance as bold creators who can express themselves, and innovative thinkers who view the world in new and insightful ways.

COLLABORATIVE TEACHING

Our collaboration with The Juilliard School brings teaching artists to our school every year. Through workshops and master classes, they inspire and mentor our next generation of performers.

EMBEDDED CURRICULUM

Our performing arts curriculum incorporates Juilliard teaching materials to enrich our students' learning experience. Our students learn from a Juilliard-curated repertoire that encompasses a broad range of genres, styles, and cultures. Engaging activities developed by The Juilliard School help our students develop creative skills such as improvisation and composition. Our outstanding teachers use the Juilliard Creative Classroom, an online resource of teaching materials, recordings, and videos, to support your child in engaging deeply with music.

The programs are offered at three of our sister schools: Collège du Léman in Switzerland, Nord Anglia Chinese International School in Shanghai and Winderemere Preparatory School in Florida.

STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES



At the heart of North Broward Preparatory's High School curriculum is the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, a holistic and academically rigorous course of study that prepares students for global success. Spanning a wide range of disciplines and languages, the IB Diploma challenges students to be intellectually curious, culturally aware and multilingual.

LEARNING ACROSS THE LINES

Students follow an interdisciplinary curriculum that encourages critical thinking across subjects They take courses in six areas - language and literature; language acquisition; individuals and societies; sciences; mathematics; and the arts – in addition to studying the Theory of Knowledge, completing a research-based Extended Essay and participating in extracurricular programs based around Creativity, Action and Service (CAS).

TAILORED FOR PERSONAL SUCCESS

Teachers work closely with students to create a personalized schedule aligning with their interests, strengths and goals. Our students significantly outperform the International Baccalaureate average on nearly every academic measure.

THEORY OF KNOWLEDGE (TOK)

Theory of Knowledge forms the foundation for learning and knowledge acquisition in the IB.

EXTENDED ESSAY

By producing a 4,000-word research paper on a topic of their choice, students are well-equipped for independent inquiry at the college level.

CREATIVITY, ACTION AND SERVICE (CAS)

CAS activities, encompassing the arts, physical activities and voluntary work, round out the IB program and teach students to collaborate outside of the classroom.

PAMOJA ONLINE EDUCATION

Diploma candidates may enroll in a Pamoja course for a subject not offered at NBPS. Students taking an online course enjoy a study hall scheduled during their timetable to allow for the completion of online tasks during the school day. The courses are offered for an additional fee. 
- Raptor System Visitor Management System
